Autumn: The Mayans

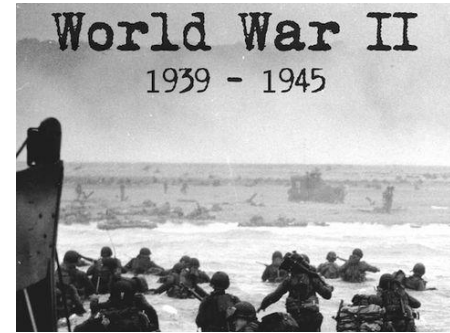
