HOMework

Children will bring home their homework books on a Friday. This will contain the spellings for the test the following Friday. They can practise these in their books or on paper.

There will also be a set times tables to work on each week. Each short term the children will be given an activity to complete relating to our topic. This term the children will be asked to make something Egyptian. More details to follow!

Children should read to an adult every night and record this in their reading record which is checked every day.

Mathletics and TTRS should also be completed weekly.

READING

Year 2 children will read with an adult at least once a week and will be sent home with up to three books. Please take time to read with your children and talk about the books with them. This should be recorded in the reading records which will be checked daily.

KS2 children are mostly free readers but will read with an adult once a week

Studies have shown that those who read for pleasure have higher levels of self-esteem and a greater ability to cope with difficult situations. Reading for pleasure was also associated with better sleeping patterns.

Evidence suggests that children who read for enjoyment every day not only perform better in reading tests than those who don't, but also develop a broader vocabulary, increased general knowledge and a better understanding of other cultures.

PE

At Fordcombe we are extremely lucky to have specialist support for our PE lessons.

Mr Pain comes in on a Wednesday afternoon to teach PE to Years 2,3 and 4.

Children should arrive at school in the correct PE kit on these days.

Where appropriate these sessions will take place outside, so please provide long trousers/hoodies if the weather is cold.
